## CERTS Grant Opportunity

### **2040 Comp Plan Emission Goals:**

1. City-wide CO2 emissions reduction goal of 80% (2005 baseline).
2. CO2 emissions reduction goal of 100% (2005 baseline) for city facilities.

### **Grant Opportunity:**

- \$2,000-\$5,000 grant, to cover labor, minor materials and supplies
- Open to nonprofit organizations and local governments
- Community-based project, related to energy reduction
- Applications due October 8<sup>th</sup>, 4 pm
- Projects run December 2021 – December 2022
