





- > Please observe posted detour and warning signs.
- > Please do not park vehicles on streets under construction.
- > Slow down and watch for uneven surfaces.
- > Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers.
- > Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
- > Access through the site may change throughout the day as construction progresses.

## Project Schedule Update

The project Contractor is anticipated to begin work along Silver Lane on Thursday, April 29, 2021 and is anticipated to be substantially completed mid-May.

Construction tasks to be completed include:

Traffic Control/Detour  
Removal and replacement of deficient curb in isolated locations  
Replacement of existing sanitary castings  
Milling of the existing roadway pavement  
Roadway paving and striping

*The above schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.*

## Driveway Access

Generally, driveways will be accessible prior to the start of construction each morning (before 7:00 a.m.) and by the end of the day (after 8:00 p.m.). Access however can often be challenging throughout the duration of the project. If you need to access your driveway during working hours on a specific day for an event or for a delivery, please contact **Jake Grainger** to make arrangements.

Property owners will be provided advance notification when access to driveways will be restricted to accommodate the removal and replacement of deficient curb in isolated locations. Once the concrete is placed, it cannot be driven on for 7 days for curing. Property owners will be allowed to park along Silver Lane until the concrete has cured and access is made available to their driveway.

## Special Deliveries, Weddings, Graduations, Garage Sales, Etc.

If you are anticipating a special delivery, open house, or any other activity during the summer construction schedule, please notify **Jake Grainger** of the time and date this will occur. The Contractor and project staff will do their best to provide access as necessary.

## Garbage Service

During construction, garbage haulers may not have access to the front of your home. Please add your home address to your trash receptacle using a piece of tape and a permanent marker. Please have your trash receptacles curbside by 6:00 a.m. on collection days. If necessary, the Contractor will move your trash receptacle to a location accessible to the garbage hauler.

## Silver Lane Detour

To complete the improvements along Silver Lane safely, Silver Lane will be closed to through traffic beginning **Thursday, April 29, 2021**. Access will be available to residents who live along Silver Lane. Advance notice signs are in place in preparation of the closure. The closure is anticipated to continue for the next two weeks, weather permitting. The detour route is shown on the next page.


## School Bus Routes
