



2022 Street and Utility Improvement Project Construction Update #14

Current Events

The 2023 construction season is underway! The Contractor is anticipated to return to the project the week of May 22nd.

Future Events

The Contractor will be on site the week of May 22nd regrading and/or reseeding settled turf areas and areas where turf has not been fully established.

Beginning the week of May 28th, the Contractor will begin miscellaneous warranty work (including adjustment of storm sewer structures) with removal/replacement of deficient concrete curb/driveway panels and final paving of the roadway tentatively scheduled the week of June 5th.

Please be aware this schedule may change as a result of weather conditions or other activities beyond the Contractor's control.

Caring for Your Newly Seeded Lawn

Please refrain from mowing your lawn shorter than 3.5-inches for at least one year following seed placement and continue to water your lawn at least 2-inches of water a week, especially during the months of June, July, and August.

Lawn Irrigation

If you have an irrigation system, please plan to turn on your system to verify the heads adjacent to the road construction area are working correctly. If you have any concerns regarding your irrigation system, please contact Katie Koscielak to set up a meeting at your property.

Tips of the Week

- If you have a lawn irrigation system that was repaired during the street reconstruction project, please take a moment to test your system is working properly. Please notify Katie Koscielak if additional repairs are necessary.
- Please don't hesitate to water your lawn if it is a hot day and you notice the seedbed is dry. Any additional watering you can provide will only result in a healthier thicker lawn.
