



## 2022 Street and Utility Improvement Project Construction Update #15

### Current Events

The Contractor has completed removal/replacement of deficient concrete curb/driveway panels Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup> and will continue with cleanup/warranty work throughout the remainder of the week.

The Contractor has filled in the low areas within the boulevard with topsoil previously in preparation for additional seeding to be completed later this week in areas that were filled in and that have not fully established from last fall.

**Final paving of Rankin Road is tentatively scheduled to be completed on Friday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting.** Following paving of your roadway:

- Do not turn your wheels at a stop condition on a newly paved road to avoid leaving impressions in the pavement.
- As soon as the rollers have made a couple of passes on the fresh asphalt you may drive on it.

### Caring for Your Newly Seeded Lawn

Please refrain from mowing your lawn shorter than 3.5-inches for at least one year following seed placement and continue to water your lawn at least 2-inches of water a week, especially during the months of June, July, and August.

If you have concerns regarding the condition of your lawn, please contact Katie Koscielak by June 14<sup>th</sup> (Wednesday) to discuss prior to the final paving of the roadway.

### Lawn Irrigation

If you have an irrigation system, please plan to turn on your system to verify the heads adjacent to the road construction area are working correctly. If you have any concerns regarding your irrigation system, please contact Katie Koscielak to set up a meeting at your property.

### Tips of the Week

- Please observe posted detour and warning signs.
- Please do not park vehicles on streets under construction.
- Slow down and watch for uneven surfaces.
- Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers.
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
- Access through the site may change throughout the day as construction progresses; your patience is appreciated.
